UNEC Distributes Wheelchairs to Persons with Disabilities and the Elderly

Bombo, Uganda – 22nd August 2025 — The Uganda Nubi Elders Council, in partnership with Amoud Relief and Development, has successfully distributed seven (7) wheelchairs to persons with disabilities and elderly individuals in Bombo, Hoima, Kampala, Kigumba, and Arua respectively.

This humanitarian initiative was made possible through the generous funding provided by Amoud Relief and Development, aimed at improving mobility, dignity, and quality of life for the most vulnerable members of our society. The wheelchair distribution was in direct response to a call made by one of the interested members of the Nubi community during the Eid al-Adha Udh-hiyah distribution exercise in Arua, where the need for mobility support among the elderly and persons with disabilities was highlighted.
